As per the rule F of the Examination regulation of Diploma "The Registration of a candidate is valid for double duration of the course period. i.e., Six Years for Diploma Regular Admission and Four Years for Lateral Entry admission," There are many students in diploma course who are having one or two back papers either in theory/Practical/Sessional exams and their registration has expired. In the interest of such students it is hereby proposed that they may be given one more chance to appear in the failed papers and complete their course. <b>Annexure-17.02</b>	Approved
17.3	Approval of replacement of FLAT Lab by DBMS Lab in 4 <sup>th</sup> Sem curriculum of B.Tech in CSE and IT Branch	DBMS is included as theory subject in 4 <sup>th</sup> sem of B.Tech CSE and IT Branch but there is no corresponding DBMS Lab in the curriculum of 4 <sup>th</sup> sem. On the recommendation of HOD, CSE/IT, BIT Sindri, it is proposed to replace FLAT Lab by DBMS Lab from AY 2024-25. National Institute of Advance Manufacturing Technology(NIAMT) which was earlier NIFFT has been granted the status of an Institution deemed to be University under distinct category by the Ministry of Education vide letter no.- NIAMT/Acad/Gen/169/2024-25/47; Date-22/04/2024. In the above referred letter Point no. 2 , UGC Regulation, 2023, para 6(6) it is stated that the existing students may get the degree from the affiliating University or Deemed to be University as per the preference of the Students. NIAMT, Ranchi has submitted the duly signed preference form of all the students except some of the Ph.D registered Students for transfer of registration/Credits/Transcripts from JUT to NIAMT. 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	affiliation of Colleges /Institutes for BBA & BCA Programmes for AY 2023-24	In the interest of the students, it is proposed to grant the extension of affiliation for AY 2023-24 only to those colleges that were granted affiliation earlier in AY 2022-23. Now the fresh affiliation and extension of affiliation in AY 2024-25 shall only be given to those colleges who have got approval of AICTE for AY 2024-25. This has been already communicated with the concerned colleges. The affiliation of the institutions shall not be allowed if the admission in the concerned courses is less than 50% for last three consecutive years effective from AY 2024-25. <b>Annexure-17.06</b>	
17.7	Approval of Adopting Academic Requirements of Working Professionals for AY 2023-24 onwards.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For B.Tech (Lateral Entry) Courses of Working Professionals as per AICTE, New Delhi guidelines 40% of credit shall be allowed to be completed through NPTEL/Swayam/MOOCs. So, it is proposed to get credits from NPTEL/Swayam/MOOCs for equivalent theory papers as per the syllabus of JUT.</li> <li>For Diploma Courses of working Professionals, all the theory and Practical papers shall be in Physical mode (as number of courses uploaded on SWAYAM/NPTEL/MOOCs for Diploma in Engg. are not sufficient) with the flexibility of convenient timings (including weekends/holidays) in alignment with the timings of the Industry / Organization.</li> <li>It is proposed that the Institutions will provide the Time Table for working Professionals to the University as well as it should be uploaded on the institute website.</li> <li>The session for working Professional will start from January (winter session) every year.</li> <li>The institutions conducting B.Tech/Diploma in Engg Program for working Professionals will have to get NAAC/NBA (Concerned Programme) accreditation by AY 2025-26.</li> </ul> <p>This matter is placed for discussion and approval of the Council. <b>Annexure-17.07</b></p>	Approved
17.8	Approval of Modification in Ordinance of M.Tech Programs of JUT.	In the current M.Tech Ordinance of M.Tech Programs of JUT, Section 8.iii A student failed due to shortage of attendance and got Incomplete grade (I grade) shall be eligible to register in the summer semester. The proposed guidelines for this kind of cases may be as follows The student will be allowed for re-registration of the concerned subjects (Theory/Practical/Audit Course/desertation) in which shortage of Attendance is marked. He/She will have to complete the entire syllabus of the subject with the junior batch and will clear the paper to pass the semester. <b>Annexure-17.08</b>	Approved
