**Report on a Five-Day State-Level Faculty Development Program on
“Entrepreneurship Development Skills for Trainers” (26-12-2018 to 31-12-2018)**

Introduction

The *Five-Day State-Level Faculty Development Program on Entrepreneurship Development Skills for Trainers* was conducted to equip faculty members with the knowledge and skills required to foster entrepreneurship among students. - **Promoting Job Creation:** Encouraging faculty to mentor students in becoming job providers, contributing to the local and national economy.

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
