Gender Audit Report - GGSESTC College

Introduction:

GGSESTC College demonstrates a commitment to gender sensitivity through various policies and facilities aimed at promoting inclusivity and addressing the needs of women employees and students.

I. Gender Sensitive Facilities

- 1. Day care facility for infants of women employees.
- 2. The medical room, equipped with beds and screens for privacy, has a lady attendant.
- 3. The medical store stocks sanitary pads, freely available to women in need.
- 4. In-house mess area within the girls' hostel promotes a secure and convenient dining environment.
- 5. Specially assigned quarters for women employees contribute to a safe living space.
- A stationary provision store run by a woman caters to the specific needs of female students.
- 7. CCTV monitoring across various campus locations ensures a secure environment.
- 8. 24-hour lady security personnel in the girls' hostel enhances safety.
- 9. Provision for maternity leave and childcare facilities.
- 10. A lady student counselor.
- 11. A Ladies common room for female faculties.
- 12. Regular Internal Gender Auditing.
- 13. Spacious and well-maintained washrooms for females, males, and physically challenged, strategically located at a distance from each other for the convenience of the students and faculties.

II. Gender Sensitive Workforce

- 1.15 % of employees are women.
- 2. Important positions held by women employees which is, Legal and Administrative Officer, IQAC Coordinator, Communication Cell Coordinator, Cultural Activities Coordinator and NSS Coordinator, and BBA BCA Coordinator.

III. Academic Initiatives:

- 1. As part of communication skills, students engage in group discussions and debates on gender sensitive topics.
- 2. Implementation of Manki Munda scholarship for girl students.
- 3. Girl students are encouraged to participate in various programmes, extracurricular activities, and sports.

IV Best Institutional Practices for Gender Equity

- 1. Systematic collection of data on gender issues.
- 2. Internal Complaints Committee for grievance redressal.
- Gender Supportive initiatives such as seminars and workshops addressing women's issues.
- 4. Organizational Support to women employees.
- 5. Zero Tolerance towards gender discrimination.



Figure B represents a graphical representation of gender segregated data pertaining to enrollment of our students in MBA program across five years.










Figure E is a graphical representation of gender segregated data pertaining to training and placement, over the 5 years, among various disciplines.










